We have an opportunity for a **trainee youth worker**.

We are currently building a team to reach out to the Muslim minorities. Our Team Co-ordinator have established the environment for new team members to come and join them in the following vision:

To build and support the local church and Muslim Background Believers in this area.

The work will include evangelism amongst the Muslim people and discipleship of young believers.

As a trainee youth worker you will:

- Experience life in a Muslim city, learning a different culture
- Devote a large part of your week to learning the language
- Develop relationships with local Muslim young people and share your faith with them in appropriate ways
- Organize activities for youth under the leadership of a newly-planted multinational church
- Receive on-the-job training as you experience what church planting is like in a cross-cultural setting

We are looking for someone who:

- Has a heart to see youth come to know the Lord and to grow in their faith
- Is adventurous and flexible
- Is willing to learn
- Is a team-player and can work under church leaders
- Wants to commit at least 2 years to service

The amount of involvement in youth work will increase over the period of the assignment. At first a lot of time will need to be spent in learning the language. This is a long-term task: language learning is likely to take at least two years.
